DUARE SARKAR CAMP VISIT BY BIJANBARI DEGREE COLLEGE (19/11/2022)

The IQAC of the Bijanbari Degree College under the coordinator Mr Adit Pariyar along with a few teachers and students visited the Duare Sarkar camp organised by the Govt of West Bengal in Pulbazar, Bijanbari, on 19/11/2022 for a general awareness session with the field workers.

Duare Sarkar is a government camp run by the present West Bengal government, which is held from time to time in different districts of the state. The government camp name Duare Sarkar's lexical meaning will be at the doorstep of the government. That is, it will be a government-run system that will be held in every district. Where the government officials give service to all West Bengal citizens. Basically, it is a system of bringing government aid to the doorsteps of the people. Thus in this camp the students were taken to learn more about the loan scheme of the Govt of West Bengal also known as "West Bengal Student Credit Card". In this visit the following points were explained to the students.

- 1. As the name suggests, the WBSCC scheme provides a collateral-free loan of up to INR 10 lakh to students at a nominal interest rate of 4%. These can be availed via any state cooperative bank, affiliated central cooperative banks, district cooperative banks, or public/private sector banks.
- 2. The Higher Education Department of the West Bengal government rolled out the WBSCC scheme to help students pursue higher education without getting drowned in the heavy interest burden that usually accompanies personal loans. It is a security-free forwarding to help deserving students access quality education. The WBSCC supports students to continue their education, be it secondary, higher secondary, undergraduate, post-graduate, or madrasah, and includes professional degrees and other equivalent courses in any specified institute within the country or outside. The scheme even covers those who are appearing for competitive exams, such as medical, law, engineering, IPS, IAS, and more.
- 3. The eligibility requirements to benefit from the Student Credit Card scheme of West Bengal are: (A) The applicant must be between 15 and 40 years of age. (B)They must be an Indian National and a West Bengal resident for the last ten years or more on the card application date. (C)The applicant must have completed their Class IX education from any recognized boards in the state. (D)They must be enrolled for higher studies within the country or abroad.

Thus in this visit the students learned many this about the scheme and were sensitized on different aspects of the program.
